

Gurkha Seduction Robustos

This medium bodied smoke is made using a Habano seed Ecuadorian wrapper which lends this cigar a nice spice and hint of sweetness. The filler is comprised of 100% Columbian Corojo tobacco which gives this cigar its unique flavor profile and rich body, the filler is held together with an aged Dominican Olor binder. The result is an extremely well balanced cigar jammed packed with flavor and complexity. Provides flavors of wood, coffee, sweet fruits and caramel.

Oliva Nub 460 Sun Grown

A novel concept in handmade cigars from Oliva....a substantive blend that will make you rethink the cigar experience. Nub cigars started as a theory. Born in the Oliva factory, a cigar maker was hell-bent on proving he could capture the essence - the core - of a cigar's flavor immediately upon lighting and throughout the duration of the smoke. So, they decided to create a cigar of this size, the first of its kind, the NUb Habano 460 cigar.

Oliva Nub 460 Maduro

The innovators behind this cigar discovered that at 4 inches in length and between 58 and 66 rings, the "Nub" delivered almost instantaneous flavor upon ignition, yet smoked for a similar duration (average 1 hour) as other cigars that, at least visually, appear almost double the size.



Oliva Serie V Double Robusto

The Oliva Serie 'V" cigar is full-bodied and full-flavored, offering layers of coffee, spice, and tobacco flavors, with a touch of dark, unsweetened chocolate on the finish. The Oliva Serie V Double Robusto was Rated 92 (Outstanding) on Cigar Aficionado magazine, which described it as "an impeccably constructed cigar with great oils and rich color. The draw is perfect, imparting significant earth and coffee bean flavors that linger on the finish.

Oscar Leaf By Oscar Sixty Maduro

The special feature of "The Leaf" is, however, far more impressive. While traditional manufacturers rely on films and other packaging materials, gets "The Leaf" a self-sheathing. Tobacco leaves are used for the protection of the cigar. This method of wrapping each individual cigar in a leaf doesn't just make it stand out and look interesting, it also serves a purpose, protecting the natural oils of the cigar.

Alec Bradley Prensado Robusto

Beautifully made, the cigar has a Trojes, Honduras wrapper with Nicaraguan binder and Honduran and Nicaraguan fillers in a nice torpedo format. The Prensado Robusto offers you rich tobacco flavor with a blend of woodsy, fruity flavours with notes of juniper and smoked meat

H.Upmann Coronas Major Tubos

In the case of the Coronas, the cigars are always hand rolled but in the case of the Eminentes they can be both hand rolled or machine rolled. The blend is the same in the two versions. A powerful cigar with a pretty good taste. A powerful cigar which produces a very tasty smoke. Direct, this Corona needs a well paced smoke to avoid burning. Once only produced as a machine made cigars, Habanos did the right thing and now roll these by hand, presented in Tubos format.



Montecristo No. 2

It's rich and intense taste gives it incomparable style, as its powerful last third covers the palate with spicy and creamy aromas that stay long after the cigars has been laid down. The punchy Montecristo flavors are delivered in an intensive and ever growing manner, giving the Montecristo No.2 true power in a progressive smoke, thus defining it as one of the great Cuban cigars of character. Aficionados of this shape have renewed their patronage to this legenda

Hoyo De Monterrey Epicure No. 2 R 731.50

This Robusto will appeal to most smokers, distinguished by a careful selection of their leaves - wrapper, filler and binder- which have been aged for a period of at least 2 years. The wrapper dressing these Habanos comes from the top leaves of the Tapado - shade grown- black Cuban tobacco plant, and is relevant characteristic that identifies these special productions. This wrapper is usually darker than the wrappers of regular range sizes of the brand

Partagas Serie D No. 4

This cigar is much sought after by those who wish to smoke complex full bodied cigars. The flavour of the blend makes it an attractive choice for those who seek a full bodied and complex Habanos while still remaining smooth and creamy. This cigar is a must have in every connoisseurs humidor, a true Cuban super star. A marvelous draw. Very generous smoke, marked by a special earthiness, with some fresh cedar wood notes.

Cohiba Siglo II

Made from the finest Vuelta Abajo tobacco, the Siglo II is inviting to look at, tender to touch and a treat to the palate, this small cigar works hard to make its mark. Cohiba have worked hard to give this smaller cigar a character all of its own. Honey and Cohiba's trademark grassy qualities are clearly apparent in the first half of the smoke. The second and third phases release cocoa and vanilla beans on to the palate through an impressively thick smoke.



Romeo Y Julieta No. 2

The Romeo Julieta No.2 are the same cigars as the No.1 just slightly smaller so again are suitable for almost any occasion and level of smoking experience. The smoke provides pleasant leathery, and typical Cuban flavours without too much intensity, which are balanced with slight hints of fruity essences. They make a great un-obtrusive, yet enjoyable mid day smoke or an ideal introduction to premium cigar smoking.

Blackstone Cherry
